The Bosch 26eco+ gas hot water system is a highly efficient fully condensing appliance, which, unlike traditional hot water systems has a condensing unit to capture heat from the exhaust gas using it to preheat incoming cold water. A secondary heat exchanger within the appliance provides maximum efficiency while for greater water savings the unit can be teamed with up to four temperature controllers.
